The Competition

Northcliffe's annual photography competition is designed for all Northcliffians to participated (plus those outside Northcliffe). You don't need any special equipment or skills – just a single creative bone in your body plus a mobile phone will do it.

The majority of entrants end up with a free mounted print of one of their photos to display in their home or give away as a present at the end of the exhibition following the competition.

To get some ideas, start by walking around your house or garden, or somewhere you are visiting, and point your camera or mobile phone in an unconventional direction. Up from the ground, down from a rooftop, through a beer glass, into a rear vision mirror... We encourage the broadest interpretation of the very broad theme 'From a Different Angle'.

There is no need to print your photos. Just choose up to 5 of your best images and email them to the Northcliffe CRC.
